Please reserve **Sunday, July 29th** on your calendar as St. Alban's is invited to join St. Jude's in their annual walk in the ***Pride Parade*** to show our support for inclusivity, love and human rights for all.

Last year, 34 folks from St. Jude's - two clergy, one choir director, one warden, one Huron College student and a large group of parishioners, their children and friends - walked the 3 km route from Western Fair to Victoria Park; others who were unable to walk joined the thousands who lined the parade route to cheer us on. Our youngest participant was three years old, and our eldest was 90. All who took part were extremely exhilarated and moved by the experience. After the walk, the group had a big celebration at the Poachers Arm pub near the park.

The details are easy - we go to church at 9:30 on July 29, meet at the fairgrounds around 11:30, and the parade leaves at 12:30. Our friends at the Poachers Arms are opening early again this year and providing a special room for the St. Alban's/St. Jude's celebration post-parade.
